Grades 5 and up

As History Detectives in training, students will use critical thinking to decipher clues to understanding North Vancouver's role in the growth of our country.

The Museum's History Interpreter will lead classes in exploring topics that complement classroom curricula. While deciphering old photographs and analyzing historical artifacts and documents, students will be challenged to investigate stories from the shipbuilding, logging, port and transportation industries. Students will discuss how our natural resources – the forest and the sea – shaped this community and will learn how immigration has influenced North Vancouver.
