North Vancouver: Then and Now encourages students to become their own photo detectives! This Classroom Extension Kit provides teachers and students with photographs featuring North Vancouver's past and present. Students will explore the concept of community by analyzing photographs that illustrate how North Vancouver has changed over time. The recommended lessons encourage cooperative learning and critical thinking.

This program is offered in response to the many requests received to provide picture sets for in-class use.

Format: Over 20 modern and archival photographs plus Lesson Plans provided. Designed to complement the Grades 2 & 3 Social Studies Prescribed Learning Outcomes. Two week loan periods available.
